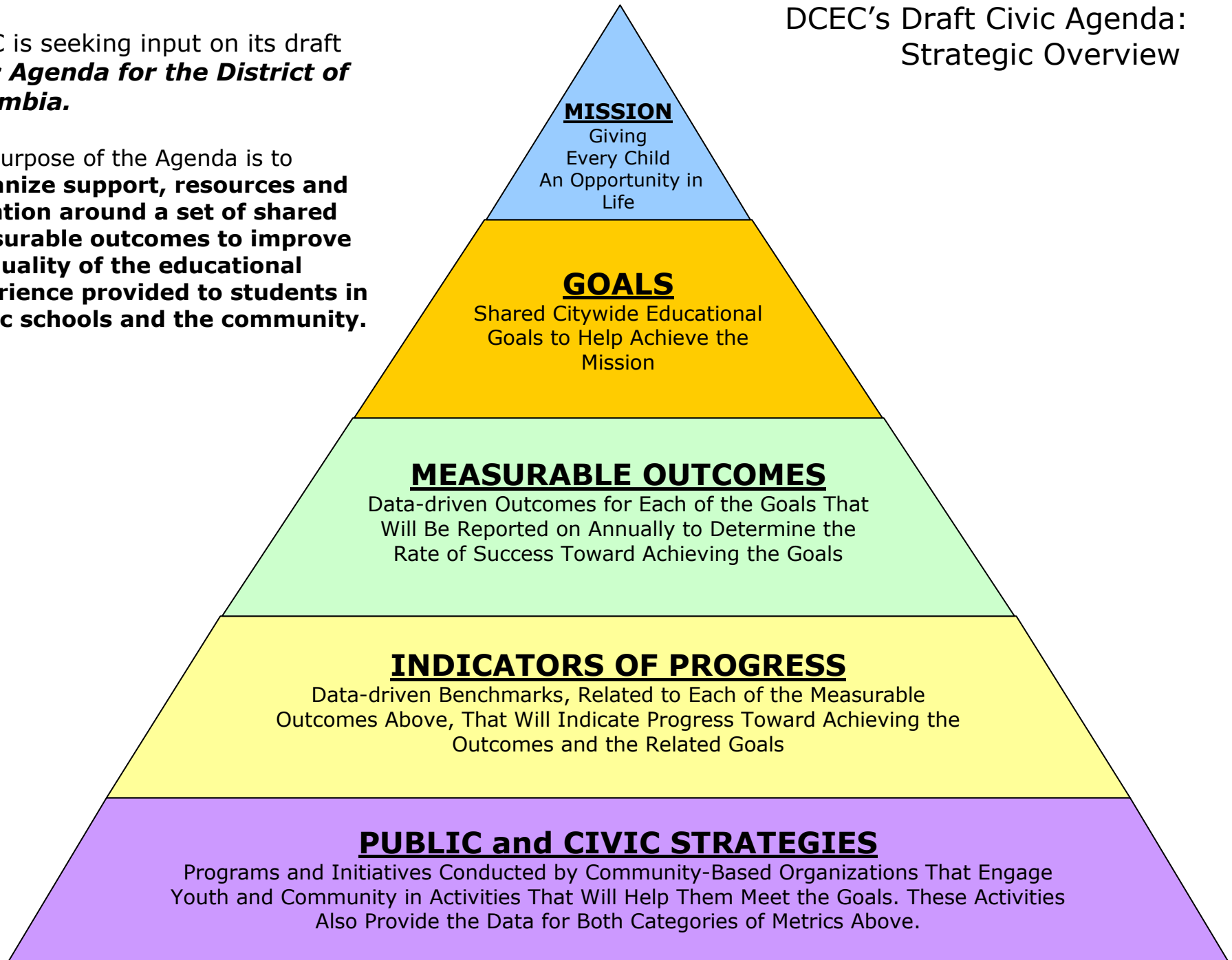


DCEC's Draft Civic Agenda: Strategic Overview
